

Our plan for progression in Art and how it meets the aims of the National Curriculum.

<p>KS1 A</p>	<p>Superheroes Drawing The children will explore the comic book art of Steve Ditko and look at logos and lettering styles using the computer. The children will create moods and show how people are feeling. They will use different tools to draw lines of different thickness.</p> 	<p>Amazing Animals Sculpture The children will be inspired by Giacometti's works and imitate sculptures of animals using tin foil. They will explore body shapes and show humans on the move through shapes and use this to draw building on last term's work and then sculpt figures in action.</p> 	<p>What a Wonderful World Colour Mixing The children will study the work of Kandinsky and look at how he uses colour and shape to create abstract art. They will build on knowledge from the first term and further develop drawing skills to create tone and shade and mix colours that are darker and lighter.</p> 
<p>KS1 B</p>	<p>Science and Story Pattern and Printing The children will find out more about William Morris and his links with our local area and the dye works. They will look at repeating patterns and designs for wall paper. They will print their pattern using a polystyrene block. *</p> 	<p>Fabulous Food and Fairy Tales <small>Drawing and Digital Art</small> The children will study two very different styles of representing food in Art. They will look at the work of Acrimboldo from the 16th century and a modern photographer Carl Warner. They will recreate their works using digital images and paintings and express their likes and dislikes.</p> 	<p>Down in the Jungle Paint and Collage The children will study the work of Henri Rousseau and his jungle paintings. They will make collages from leaf prints and drawings and explore leaf shapes and colours from exotic plants. They will build up a jungle scene using printing techniques, fabrics, colour mixing and drawing.</p> 
<p>KS2 A</p>	<p>Walk Like an Egyptian The children recognise art that has been inspired by the Ancient Egyptians. They will design their own head dresses in the Egyptian style and draw using their observational skills, adding pencil shading and textures, Focussed Artist: Gustav Klimt</p> 	<p>The Super-humans The children will learn to design and make a clay tile using techniques which they will have learnt. They will create portraits in the style of David Hockney and look at a range of Greek art eg vases Focussed Artist: David Hockney and Salvador Dali</p>  	<p>Rambling Round the Rainforest The children will create carnival masks using paper. They will use a variety of paintbrushes to paint local flowers and plants alongside the science learning. They will use wire to sculpt flowers. Focussed Artist: Romero Britto</p>
